The scrum team and stakeholders inspect the latest increment, changing market conditions, and the updated release forecasts.

After feedback and discussion, the product backlog is amended to create a plan to deliver the most relevant and valuable product possible.

Actions

- Demonstrate working product
- Discuss market conditions
- Review the forecast (e.g. with a product burn up chart)
- Prioritisation decisions are discussed regularly and transparently

- Ensure that all developers participate
- Demonstrate sprint outputs, untested or incomplete work is NOT shown
- Provide and record feedback on the working product
- Avoid product owners signing off stories
