## Refinement involves

- Removing PBIs that no longer appear relevant
- Creating new PBIs in response to newly discovered needs
- Re-assessing the relative priority of PBIs
- Assigning estimates to PBIs which have yet to receive one
- Correcting estimates in light of newly discovered information
- Splitting PBIs which are high priority but too coarse grained to fit in an upcoming iteration
- Adding acceptance criteria

## Strategies for success

- It's not an event, so it doesn't have to be a meeting
- Salami slice items ready for the next sprint
- Work in subgroups of relevant contributors
- Divide and conquer
- It's a collaboration between the Scrum
